### Honorarium Track

Local half day: \$1,000 (2 presentations, up to 2 hour travel)

Half day: \$2,000 + Travel (2 presentations)


Keynote speech: \$5,000 + Travel


Biography

For a full-day visit, no more than three presentations. Available for lunch with students and/or teachers. Dietary restriction: Vegetarian For a half-day, two presentations is the maximum allowed.



Schools will also be responsible for the following expenses:

One (1) roundtrip airline ticket from Airport or mileage if Rena is driving. If necessary, hotel accommodation (which should be coordinated with Rena and her team before booking). If the visit is an early start time, the school will be responsible for accommodation the night before (and possibly the night of the visit) if not located in Airport/City or nearby.

If necessary, school is also responsible for ground transportation from the hotel to school. Travel and accommodations should be coordinated with Author/New Leaf Literary Agency and can all be booked and sent as an invoice beforehand so the school can write one check. If local and more than 2 hours away, \$250 is required to cover the cost of travel up to 4 hours.
